The Amalfi Coast, the Archaeological Areas of Pompeii and Herculaneum and the Archaeological Site of Paestum are UNESCO World Heritage sites featured in this program. These sites are distinguished due to universal scenic, historic, artistic or scientific value.

Museo Archeologico Nazionale in Naples. With its collection of artwork and various objects from Herculaneum and Pompeii, it is one of the most important archaeological museums in the world.

Excursion: *Naples.* Enjoy a walking tour of the historic center of Naples to see the Piazza Plebiscito, Palazzo Reale and San Francesco di Paola.

DAY SIX POMPEII/HERCULANEUM B/A

Educational Focus: *The Horror and* **Splendor of Mount Vesuvius.** Learn about the history of Mount Vesuvius and





its impact on the ancient cities of Herculaneum and Pompeii.

Excursion: *Pompeii and Herculaneum*. Visit the UNESCO World Heritage sites of

Herculaneum and Pompeii, which were destroyed when Mount Vesuvius erupted in A.D. 79. Pompeii, the larger of the two cities, was covered by ash. Pompeii is known for its museum and well-preserved frescoes and mosaics. The ancient seaside town of Herculaneum was preserved by mudflows on that fateful day.

Local Flavor: Lunch is served at a restaurant next to the archaeological site of Pompeii.

DAY SEVENSORRENTO/CAPRI

Excursion: *Sorrento.* This morning, depart for lovely Sorrento. Built atop a coastal cliff, this village has been heralded by poets for its beauty. Rendered in pastelhued houses, it is ringed with groves of lemon trees and awash in beautiful gardens.

Independent Exploration: Enjoy some leisure time in Sorrento.
