Virginia, a native Iowan, was raised on a farm outside <u>Gruver</u>, <u>Iowa</u>, graduating from Gruver High School in 1941.

She played six-on-six basketball as a guard in high school, and also pitched and played first base for the men's varsity baseball team! "There just weren't enough boys at our small school so my tom-boy ways made it fun for me."

Virginia graduated from lowa in 1945 with a BS in Zoology and minors in English and Russian Literature. While walking to work on December 7, 1941 on the lowa St. Bridge, she was informed that Japan had bombed Pearl Harbor.

Virginia currently serves as TBIC's Board Member Emeritus. She began attending TBIC game watches at Bleachers in St Pete in 1996. She became a founding TBIC Board Member in 1996 and served



energetically until 2005. She said that after years of receiving only funding letters, it was good to meet up with real lowa alumni in the area and support TBIC.

Virginia started her career as a Teaching Assistant at Johns Hopkins University in 1946. She worked many years in clinical labs and in 1974 she and her husband moved to Florida. From 1974-1984 she was the Head Technologist at Mease Hospital. A couple of years ago (at 83 years young) she retired from a laboratory business office computer position that supported many health entities in Pinellas County.
