Janice & Elaine Scholarship

The Janice & Elaine Scholarship is a gift from the estate of Weldon Jack McClary and his family. Mr. McClary attended Early ISD from 1947 to 1958 and was a yell leader for the Early Longhorns. He served his country by joining the U.S. Armed Services and then became a CPA with International Petroleum Service Organization, traveling around the world gaining knowledge, experience, and success.

The scholarship is to be presented to a senior at Early High School who expects to graduate from a Texas state school with a degree or certification. This scholarship renews each semester and requires the applicant to submit very specific information to the high school in order for the funds to be disbursed. Paying for the full cost of the student's tuition, fees, books, dorm, and meal plan, the scholarship monies are to be paid directly to the state college of choice.

If, for any reason, the recipient is not able to fulfill the requirements set forth in the application, a second person deemed worthy of receiving the award will be notified. The Janice & Elaine Scholarship will be funded and offered as long as funds are available. The recipient will be chosen by a committee made up of EHS professional staff members.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a 2014-2015 graduating senior
- Must be enrolling in an undergraduate degree or certification program at an eligible institution (includes technical schools and associates degree programs)
- Must have a high school GPA of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Must show leadership, good character, & citizenship
- Must have no referrals for violation of school policy regarding drugs, alcohol, or violence
- Must demonstrate financial need (Household income cannot exceed twice the poverty level.) See chart below:

Renewal Requirements

- Must be a fulltime student once in college, enrolled in 12 hours of classes or more
- Must maintain a college GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
- Must complete a degree or certification in ten long semesters or sooner (funding ends after ten semesters, not including summer sessions)
- Must submit a transcript and degree plan at the end of each college semester before funds can be distributed for the next semester

Note: If the scholarship recipient's cumulative college GPA falls below 2.5 or if the recipient fails to register as a fulltime student, he or she will be placed on probation for one semester to correct the issues. After one semester of probation, remaining issues will cause revocation of allotted funds.

Application Requirements

- Fill out all portions of the application completely, according to the instructions, and submit by the **April 15**th deadline.
- Provide three completed recommendation forms (two from EISD educators, one personal)
- Provide a copy of high school transcript
- Provide a copy of the first page of parents' or guardians' 2014 federal tax return (1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, or 1099 SSA- Social Security Tax Form)
- Turn in the completed application (including all forms) to Mrs. Bearden by the end of the school day on **April 15**th.

Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered. All information contained within the application and forms will remain confidential.
