This is because *B. cepacia* can be passed between individuals who have CF through close proximity. *B. cepacia* infection in a person with CF can cause serious respiratory illness and, in some patients, may lead to death. Despite this policy, there might still be some individuals with *B. cepacia* in attendance. *B. cepacia* is not a risk for otherwise healthy individuals.
