Remember, your application will not be considered if it, along with all supporting materials, is postmarked after the February 12th deadline.

20. Curriculum Vitae: Please include a curriculum vitae.

21. List three persons who will write letters of recommendation evaluating your research agenda, experience, and potential. Letters of recommendation should be written by individuals who are familiar with your academic work, scholarship, writing ability, and research interests. One letter should be from your primary dissertation advisor.

The individuals writing your letters of recommendation should submit the letters in one of the following ways:

a) Send via email as a PDF attachment. The letter must be on official institutional letterhead and include an electronic signature in order to be accepted. The letters should be emailed to Karina Havrilla at [havrilla@asanet.org](mailto:havrilla@asanet.org) and include "Postdoc Letter of Recommendation for (applicant's name)" in the subject line.

b) Returned to you (the applicant) in a sealed, signed envelope to be included in your application package (if mailing in a hard copy), or mailed directly to the ASA Executive Office at the address listed below.
