#### **Reimbursement Policy**

To help you with your planning, the following is the reimbursement policy for Officers, Directors, and Committee Chairs:

Reimbursement for Directors shall consist of the following (BPGM 1.6.2.2):

- Lodging Accommodations at the hotel site selected by CSEA for the Board of Directors meeting, at the CSEA rate (up to four nights for Officers and up to two nights for Directors). The attendee is obligated to make his/her own reservations. The attendee is to be billed for and is obligated to pay for miscellaneous expenses incurred on the individual lodging portfolio. Lodging amounts will be transferred to a master billing, whenever possible. Rooms booked in a hotel other than the hotel where CSEA has a room block will not be reimbursed, unless approved in advance by the CSEA office.
- 2. Travel an amount which is the lesser of coach airfare, (the lowest fare offered by the airline) booked at least 30 days in advance, auto mileage at the current IRS standard mileage rate, or special airfare pricing negotiated by the Society. The attendee is obligated to make his\her own travel arrangements.
- 3. Requests for reimbursement for board lodging and travel expenses must be made within 30 days after the board meeting attended.
- 4. Meals, parking & incidental expenses no reimbursement.

Other Board Meeting-Related Expense Reimbursements (BPGM 1.6.2.3, amended May 2015):

The following Members shall be eligible for certain expense reimbursements related to their attendance at the Committee/Board of Directors meeting(s) as described below:

- 1. CSEA Committee Chairs and Vice Chairs may be reimbursed on the same basis as local Chapter Directors to the Board.
- 2. CSEA Nominating Committee Members may be reimbursed on the same basis as local Chapter Directors to the Board only for the meeting during which they conduct interviews of officer candidates.

There shall be no reimbursement for expenses incurred by other committee or subcommittee members without specific request through the Finance & Budget Committee and approval of the Board.

Request for reimbursement - must be made within 30 days after the board meeting attended. If you have failed to make your reservation thirty days in advance you may only be reimbursed for a lesser fare based on the ticket price of another Director from your immediate area.

#### **Additional Reimbursement Considerations**

As reported during the May, 2015 Finance and Budget Committee meeting, the Society is facing a steep decline in cash as a result of reduced registration levels for Super Seminars. Our options for reducing cash expenses between now and December are limited, but one area that has been identified is travel reimbursements. At the Board meeting, several members spoke up and offered that either they, or their Chapter, could absorb some or all of the travel expense. This is a case where every bit helps; our Board is large and the combined cost of travel and lodging is approximately \$20,000 per meeting. Therefore, we appreciate your advance consideration of this important matter, and encourage you to bring the discussion to your Chapter Board, if appropriate.

# 2015-2016 Committee Consideration Form

Any CSEA regular Member is qualified to serve on a committee – volunteering for a CSEA committee is a wonderful way to get involved, network, and shape the future of CSEA. Committees meet three times per year in conjunction with the Board meeting, with occasional conference calls throughout the year when needed.

With the exception of positions for the Nominating Committee, which are filled via appointment by the Board of Directors, all committee Chairs are responsible for appointing their committee, which consists of members and supporting members. A committee member is an individual appointed to the committee with a right to vote. A "supporting member" is an individual who does not have the right to vote, but has an interest in the work of the committee.

The following CSEA Committee mission statements are provided to assist you in determining the committees where you feel you would make the most impact. A committee consideration form follows, which allows you to choose which committees you would like to serve on.

<u>Audit</u>: To ensure the Society's financial statements and disclosures are validated and to evaluate the Society's accounting procedures.

**Bylaws:** To ensure the organizational documents of the Society and Chapters conform to law and are reflective of the desires and needs of Members; and to ensure appropriate conformity of organizational and operational documents of the Chapters, the Society and the National Association.

Education: To produce quality programs which meet the educational and financial goals of the Society.

Ethics & Professional Conduct (E&PC): To ensure all CSEA Members observe high standards of ethical and professional conduct.

Finance & Budget (F&B): To ensures the Society's financial integrity.

**Legislative Affairs:** To watch, protect and promote the interests of the Enrolled Agent; and to be informed and inform Members of new laws or changes to existing laws which affect the general public and the profession of Enrolled Agents. To advise the Legislature of the effects of existing or proposed legislation on taxpayers and practitioners.

Membership & Chapter Development: To achieve universal membership of California Enrolled Agents in the Society.

**Political Action (PAC)**: To ensure a presence of the Society in the California Legislature.

**Public Information & Awareness (PIA)**: To enhance the visibility and recognition of Enrolled Agents as the preferred tax professionals and to promote CSEA Members to the general public.

<u>Scholarship (a Committee of the Education Foundation)</u>: To provide scholarships aimed at increasing the level of knowledge of current Enrolled Agents and potential Enrolled Agent candidates.
