Student Award "FSP Excellence in Financial Education":

The award recognizes a top student in an eligible graduate or upper level financial related course. Eligible courses may be determined at the discretion of the college/university, with the understanding that the award is limited to $\underline{10}$ award recipients per school per calendar year. The recipient is determined by the professor of the course and may be based on a criterion such as top grade. The award includes a complimentary calendar year student membership in the Society of FSP, and other articles of special recognition.
