I. ENTRY INFORMATION

Priority will be given to teams attending the Las Vegas Tournament during the President's Day Weekend, during February 19-21, 2005. Teams not attending the Las Vegas Tournament will be placed on the "Wait List" and will be accepted to fill and complete the tournament field.

II. ROSTERS AND REGISTRATION

ROSTERS

There is a maximum of fifteen (15) players on the roster. All participants listed on the roster must be registered with USA Volleyball.

COACHES MEETING:

General Coaches Meeting will be held at Manoa District Park, New Gym
Saturday Morning, February 12, 2005 at 7:30am.

All teams are required to have a Team Representative or Coach at the mandatory meeting. Playing rules and tournament policies and procedures will be reviewed at this time.

ON-SITE TEAM CHECK-IN

Team Registration: Team representatives or coaches whose teams play in this event are required to check in by no later than 7:30 am on Saturday & Sunday for their pool assignments.

On Site Coordinator: There will be an On-Site Coordinator at Manoa District Park overseeing the tournament, ensuring that the tournament runs smoothly and assisting in any tournament issues.

UNIFORM

Numbered jerseys are required. No duplicate numbers. Uniforms in same color is preferred. Shorts must be of the same color.

III. TOURNAMENT FACTS AND INFORMATION

GYM RULES AND REGULATIONS –

Concession stands will be available at the Manoa District Park. Please help and assist us in keeping the area free of rubbish.

FUTURE USE OF THESE FACILITIES DEPENDS ON OUR ABILITY TO FOLLOW THESE RULES

PARKING:

Parking at Manoa District Park is free. Please observe all parking signs. There are turnaround areas fronting Manoa District Park which are patrolled by Police and there have been times of towing – so please observe all signs! FYI – fine for illegal parking is \$250.00 PLUS towing fee ...

ATHLETIC TRAINERS –

There will be no athletic trainers available. Ice and bags will be provided if necessary.

PLAYING SITES AND SCHEDULE:

18's Schedule

Saturday, Sunday

FORMAT – Round robin pool play on Saturday for seeding will precede the championship round on the Sunday. Each team will play a minimum of 6 matches.

Matches will be the best two out of three games.

- Rally scoring to 25 points, win by 2 points, with a 27 point cap
 - If score is 26-26, the winner of the next rally, wins the game.
- If a third deciding game is required it will be rally scoring to 15 points win by 2, no cap and the teams will switch sides at 8.
- Two time outs per game, 30 seconds each
- Twelve team substitutions
- Let serve
- Libero rule in effect
- Two Minutes between games

GAME TIMES - The first match of any round may not begin before its scheduled time. Within a round, a match may be advanced from the scheduled starting time.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES – There will be a total of 10 minutes warm-up prior to the start of each match. The first two minutes will be shared courts, no hitting over the net. The court will be available for the Serving Team only for four minutes. The next four minutes will be for the Receiving Team. Please incorporate your serving within your allocated time.

Due to the length of time we have for each gym, we will have court managers on site to ensure that the times are kept.

TEAM OFFICIATING ASSIGNMENTS - Each team is responsible for: 1-Referee, 1-Umpire, 2 linespersons, 1 official scorekeeper, 1 libero tracker, and 1 scoreboard keeper. Failure to provide QUALIFIED officiating crew for your next assigned match will result in the forfeit of the first game of your next match. For every minute the officiating team is late, one point is given to the next opponents, up to the 25-0 forfeit. The second offense will result in the loss of your next match, and may affect next year's entry.

WHISTLES – For sanitary reasons, we recommend that teams provide their own whistles.

POOL PLAY ASSIGNMENTS - The officiating and playing teams for each pool will be designated within the pool schedule.

ELIMINATION BRACKET ASSIGNMENTS – Teams will be placed according to pool play. Every effort will be done to position teams where they do not play teams from previous pool play. However, after first round of play, competition against pool play opponents may occur. Please ensure that you check the Playoff Schedule to ensure that you are cleared to leave. Teams may need to referee after their final match.

PROTEST PROCEDURE - If a protest is to be filed it must be done at the time of the incident, no later. Only the floor captain may file the protest. The protest must be written on the score sheet by the scorer or the official and must be signed by both the floor captain and the referee. The protested game will be completed but before the next game begins the protest must be ruled upon. A protest cannot be filed after the completion of the match. Judgment calls may NOT be protested.

AWARDS

Team awards for 1st and 2nd place teams and medals for 1st place team players.

TIE BREAKERS FOR ALL COMPETITION

The following will be used in determining tie breakers:

1. 2-Way tie: Head to Head
2. 3-Way tie:
 - a. Match Percentage
 - b. Game Percentage
 - c. Most Points Differential
 - d. Pull Cards from a deck of 10 cards

IV. SPECIFIC ELIGIBILITY RULES

TOURNAMENT - GENERAL

1. Entries will be limited to a maximum of 16 teams for all 18U age divisions. All teams will advance to the single elimination Championship round.
2. Finals are scheduled for Sunday, February 13.

AGE DEFINITION

18 and under division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 1986 OR players who were born on or after September 1, 1985 AND a high school student during some part of the current academic year.

All persons whose names appear on the official Roster, including players, coaches, team representatives, chaperones, trainers, managers, et al must be registered with USAV. The purpose of this is the extension of the USAV's liability insurance program or in the event a USA Territory FIVB Federation Member purchasing event insurance. This will ensure all registered USAV players, coaches, team representatives, chaperones, managers, trainers, et al at this Event have liability coverage and Sports Accident Insurance (this is an excess coverage plan).
