Dear GW resident,

The Wardening team would like to congratulate you for joining Imperial College and welcome you to one of the friendliest, social and supportive Halls in the college. This letter introduces Garden & Weeks (GW) hall and the Wardening team and gives important information for your arrival.

GW Hall is run by a Wardening team of four: the warden is Dr João Cabral (lecturer in Chemical Engineering), the assistant warden is Dr Martyn McLachlan (Research Fellow, Materials) and the sub-wardens Elly Jay (PhD student in Materials) and Marco Visentini Scarzanella (PhD student in Computing) and The hall supervisor is Vladimir Jarina who looks after all facilities. In addition, GW has nine Hall Seniors (second year residents) and a student-elected Hall Committee.

The Wardening team looks after your welfare, organises a busy programme of events, and makes sure everyone respects the (very reasonable) GW rules. You will get to know us well and should feel free to contact us about any concerns or problems, or just to have a chat. A member of the team is available every night from 7pm to 7am during the week and 24hrs during the weekend. GW houses 145 fresher students in two unique (grade II listed) buildings in South Kensington (SK), minutes from Imperial SK campus and next door to the Sports Centre. Weeks (64 students) is a building from the late 50's while Garden (81 students) is a row of Victorian houses from the 1850's. GW hall has single, double and triple rooms, and seven common rooms, sitting and study areas (equipped with flat screen TVs, two pianos, pool and table tennis), a computer room, even a student run café-bar "Bonkies" and a large back garden. GW has shared kitchens, with lockable cupboard and fridge space, and coin-operated laundries in the basement. Each resident has a telephone extension and internet connection to Imperial's network.
