[Exercise Doesn't Compensate For Kids' Screen Time](#)

Time spent in front of the computer or television screen is associated with psychological problems in children, no matter how physically active the child is, according to a new study. That means kids can't make up for lots of TV time by spending extra hours running around, the researchers report in the November issue of the journal *Pediatrics*. The findings also suggest that the way kids spend their sedentary time, not just how much of it they have, matters for mental health. (Please click on the title above for the online article.)




