Animé Los Angeles is a new fan-run convention, “on the other side of the year” – in the winter, instead of the summer like so many of the other fine events that celebrate the animé/manga industry.

Caroline “Carmen” Curtis, our artist guest of honor, is the writer/artist behind the popular manga-style webcomic “9th Elsewhere.” **Fred Patten**, author of “Watching Anime, Reading Manga: 25 Years of Essays and Reviews,” has been a part of animé fandom since the very beginning. **Jerry Koudelik** (aka “Sprite Monkey”) creates the web-based series “Secret of Mana Theater,” inspired by the popular video game. **Tadao Tomomatsu**, who has been eaten by Godzilla, is known for his improv performance as “Mr. Shake-Hands Man” on Banzai TV.

Hotel – Our hotel is the Airtel Plaza Hotel in Van Nuys. The convention rate for single king and double queen rooms is just **\$79/night** plus tax (\$89 triple, \$99 quad). Overnight parking is \$8/night for hotel guests, or \$5 for day parking.

Dances – On Friday DJ Tw-e-k will bring you high energy J-remix and eurodance music. Saturday night DJ :Lynx: will run “Adrenochrome South” with a lot of industrial, fan-friendly 80s remixes, futurepop, and synthpop.

Hospitality Suite – Also known as the Con Suite, this is where you’ll find soft drinks & snacks to tide you over between meals. We don’t want you to drop from starvation or dehydration, because that’s just no fun. It will be open to all members, every day and evenings too.

Cosplay Friendly – Have you ever worn a costume and had one of the buttons come loose? The “Costume Repair Station” is where you’ll be able to sit down with a needle and thread (or glue and duct tape) to fix something that went wrong, touch up your makeup, or take that vinyl headpiece off and breathe deeply for a few minutes. 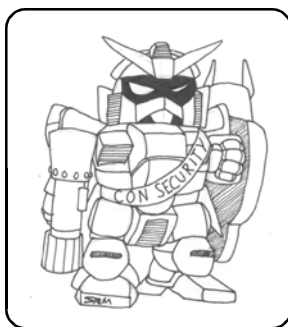
Artists Concourse – Some tables will be available for artists to showcase their work, take commissions, and so forth.
