- Prepare spiritually.** Seek to be worthy of the guidance of the Spirit and ask the Lord for help as you prepare to meet the needs of the family.
- Discover family goals.** Ask the family what they would like to accomplish during your visit.
- Request access.** Help the family set up a FamilySearch account, then ask for permission to explore the family’s tree.
- Search the family’s tree prior to the visit.** Use the Helper Function to explore the family’s tree. If desired, use Partner resources to make your search more efficient.
- Prepare a personalized lesson.** Help the family accomplish their goal and feel the Spirit of Elijah.
- Consider how to help the family to take names to the temple.**
