If you do not answer all the questions, we will have to write to you for the information, and we may have to stop your benefit in the meantime.

If there is not enough room on the form for you to write everything that you need to, please use the space in section 7. It will help us if you make it clear which part of the form it is that your information is about.

If you need any advice or have any problems filling in the form or providing proof, please ring us on the above phone number. If you want, we can arrange to send someone to see you in your home.

Use black ink to fill in this form and send it back to us as soon as you can.

Even if you do not have the proof we need at the moment, send this form back straight away. You can send us the proof or information later but please make sure you send **original documents** and put your name and address on everything you send.
