Course Details/Requirements:

- Participants must be current in Adult/Child/Infant CPR with AED and First Aid.*
- Course takes approximately three days, depending on number of instructor candidates.
- Course includes *Fundamentals of Instructor Training*, course knowledge and content, administrative procedures and practice teaching sessions.
- Each candidate will be graded on three practice teaching sessions (facilitation, presentation and demonstration).
- Each candidate must score an 80% on the final written exam.
- Approximate cost is \$80 for materials.

**Note: If the Base level course is added to the Instructor course, it will take four days.*
