Student Representative to the Board (SRB) Award

Purpose

The ASID SRB of the Year award recognizes an ASID student representative to the professional chapter board who has demonstrated exemplary dedication to their position and service to their professional chapter.

Nomination Submission Process:

- 1. The SRB award recipient is selected through a nomination process. Student chapter presidents, professional chapter leaders, student affair chairs, faculty advisors, and ASID Student Advisory Council members are eligible to nominate candidates. Fill out the attached form and e-mail to ASID headquarters at futureofdesign@asid.org or fax to (202) 546-3240, along with one letter of recommendation from yourself.
- 2. Once a candidate is nominated, s/he will receive notification of the nomination from ASID headquarters and will be asked to provide supporting documentation. See below for list of submission materials.
- 3. The SRB award recipient is selected from the submitted complete applications.

Candidate Submission Materials

(must include the following items)

One letter of recommendation from an ASID professional member, faculty member, Student Advisory Council member fellow ASID student leader. The letter should share specific examples of activities the SRB has accomplished that					
exemplify the ASID brand					
• demonstrate ASID leadership and ASID initiatives, such as interior design legislation and/or sustainable design					
• detail how the SRB has improved interaction between the professional chapter and its associated student chapters					
☐ 200 – 500 word typed essay written by the candidate,					
stating the candidate's accomplishments during her/his SRB tenure					

• include specific examples such as "traveled to all ASID student chapters in region"

Correct ASID branding and use of the ASID logo is required in all communication.

Nomination Application and one letter of recommendation must be received at March 22, 2013. Late nominations will not
be considered.
Candidate Submission Materials—including additional letter(s) of recommendation—must be received by March 22, 2013.
Late submissions will not be considered.
