The Art department are delighted to be able to offer our A Level students the opportunity to visit The Victoria and Albert Museum on **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2015**. Although the visit is not essential to the A Level course, it will support your son / daughter with their analytical and critical understanding of artists/textile designers and photographers. This trip will provide opportunities to create drawings and photographs for sketchbooks, ideas for the written element and this will be assessed as part of the A2 Level unit 3 Personal Investigation.

Students will use the Architecture galleries as inspiration, Sabine's work looks at geometry in architecture as a starting point for creating jewellery and other embellishments for fashion and the body. Students will also visit the Alexander McQueen 'Savage Beauty' exhibition and visit the photography exhibitions by Julia Margret Cameron and the India and Burma exhibit.

The trip will leave on **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June** at 7:00am, returning at approximately 8:00pm. The total cost of this trip will be £25.
