STUDENT BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

- 1. I understand and accept that only I am responsible for my actions and their consequences. Only I can choose my behavior or choose to be affected by the behaviors of others.
- 2. I will be courteous and considerate to all students, faculty and substitutes. I will not touch/take/use the personal materials of others. I will not write on the desks or bulletin boards. I will respect the personal space of my classmates and my teacher.
- 3. I will arrive to class on time and bring all of my materials every day. If the tardy bell rings and I am not sitting in the classroom, I will go to the office and get a tardy slip. I understand that if I fail to have any materials required for class (pen, notebook, book, assignment) that I will be subject to the appropriate reprimand.
- 4. I will have only one hall pass per six weeks. I will only be allowed to use this pass during independent study work time. If I do not use my pass, I understand that I will lose it and be reissued a new one for the new six weeks.
- 5. I will begin copying the assignment and/or the warm-up activity within one minute after entering into the classroom.
- 6. I will raise my hand before asking a question or making a comment. I will patiently wait to be called on before I begin speaking and I will respect other people's opinion even if I do not agree with it.
- 7. I will listen to others and participate in classroom discussions. I will do my best to have a positive attitude and work well with others during group projects or when working in pairs. I also understand that not contributing to the group/pair will result in me receiving a lower grade, possibly a zero.
- 8. I will use polite speech and body language at all times. In understand that part of being an adult is learning to be mature and responsible for my actions.
- 9. I will complete my own assignments. I will not copy papers from my classmates or cheat on a daily assignment, an essay, a test or a project. If I need assistance of have a question on a test, I know that the only person I can ask, without it being considered cheating, is the teacher.
