- In the event that there are more than 3 individuals from the same chapter applying for this award, the chapter will be contacted and a nomination process must take place to decide which 3 applications will be submitted for grading.

- Provide the information in resume format
- Provide overall GPA
- TWO PAGE LIMIT

PROVIDE A PERSONAL STATEMENT

- Limited to one page, double spaced, 12 pt font
- You should use the personal statement to provide context and personal insight to your list of accomplishments, involvements and activities.
- PROMPT: How has Greek Life impacted your personal growth and enhanced your collegiate experience?

PROVIDE TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- Limited to one page per recommendation
- . Include "Greek Woman of the Year" centered at the top of the first page (can be in the header)
- Include your name and chapter affiliation at the top of the page (*can be in the header*)
- The name of the individual writing the recommendation and his/her relationship to applicant should be included

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION SHOULD ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- Describe the positive impact the nominee has made on both the Greek community and their own chapter
 - Provide specific examples of how they have impacted individual members, the chapter as a whole, and other Greek organizations they belonged to.
 - Articulate how the examples you are providing have been impactful to the Greek community and their own chapter.
- Describe the positive impact the nominee has made on the UC Irvine community
 - Provide specific examples of how their involvement in organizations (student and campus) outside of Greek Life has positively impacted the overall UCI campus community.
 - Articulate how the examples provided have been impactful to individual students or to entire the organization.
- Describe how the nominee lives their fraternal values.
 - Provide specific examples how the nominee lives their values as a member of their sorority and in the leadership positions they have held in the Greek and UCI community.

- Describe how the nominee is committed to academics
 - Articulate how the nominee makes academics a priority and how they exhibit that as a member and leader in the Greek community.
- Describe how the nominee is committed to service and philanthropy
 - Provide specific examples of the commitment the nominee has made to philanthropy and service.
 - Articulate how their commitment to service and philanthropy has made an impact on their chapter, the Greek Community, and UC Irvine.
