

Secondary Admissions for Academy and Career Technical Programs

In accordance with Title 18A:54-20.1, the sending district's Board of Education in any county in which there is a county vocational school, shall send to the county vocational school district each pupil who resides in the school district or the regional school district, who has applied for admission to, and who has been accepted for attendance, in a county vocational technical school district. Furthermore, the statute states that the local Board of Education shall pay the tuition, if any, for each of these pupils to attend the county vocational school pursuant to subsection C of the statute. In addition, the resident district is also responsible for the pupil's transportation.

The ACVSD Board of Education, through its authorized designees, has the responsibility to determine appropriate programs of study for all students who seek enrollment and to refuse admission of a student to a program, which is determined by staff to be unsuitable. Placement, attendance, standardized test results, grade point average, discipline/behavior, and counselor recommendation are reviewed by a committee composed of administrators and coordinators. An aggregate point system will be applied to rank students; those individuals with the highest totals will be recommended for acceptance. Sending districts are requested to notify parents and students of the admission procedures.
