Royalty will be asked to wear their formal attire, sashes and crowns since there will be a group photo taken on the East steps of the Capitol.





Dear Royalty,

At the end of this letter is a list of things we would like you to do in preparation for the Royalty Day at the Capitol on June 17<sup>th</sup>. The "PARTY @ MI PLACE" Royal Luncheon is the perfect opportunity for you to share your event brochures with your legislatures. So be sure to bring some along.

The following is a letter you may copy and send to your legislatures to invite him/her to the Michigan Festivals and Events Association and Foundation "PARTY @ MI Place" Royal Luncheon. Attached are the names and addresses of your legislatures and the formal invitation you need to include in your letter. Feel free to personalize your letter. This sample letter is just a helpful tool to get you started. Handwritten correspondence is more personal and receives more attention so we recommend that you hand write your invitation and use your event's official letterhead if possible (but it is not mandatory). Please send us a copy of the letter you are sending to your legislature so we know your legislature has received an invitation from you.

It is very important that you inform Michigan Festivals and Events Association regarding the RSVP for lunch that you receive from your legislatures. You can do that by sending an email to media@mfea.org.

- □ Write letter to personally invite legislature (see sample letter) and be sure to include a copy of the invitation with it. Legislatures' calendars get filled up quickly so mail it as soon as possible

- □ Write thank you to Legislature's response to your invitation letter letting him/her know you received their response and tell them that you will meet them at the table under the tent labeled with their district number on it.
- □ Inform MFEA regarding Legislature's RSVP (media@mfea.org or phone: 989-845-2080)
- □ Plan on arriving early enough to park and walk over to the Capitol and be ready by 11:00.
- □ Bring brochures to share with legislatures (may bring gift pack with buttons, t-shirts etc. that represent your event to give to your legislatures-this is just an option)
- □ Wear crown, sashes, formal wear
- $\Box$  Group photo will be taken on the Capitol steps at the end of the program (1:00).
