Lower School

Lower school students have a relaxed dress code, as we believe an informal environment encourages active participation in the classroom. It is expected that all children dress in neat and appropriate clothing and that undergarments not be visible at any time. The Dean of Students has final say regarding the appropriateness of a student's clothing.

- Certain clothing is not allowed, such as t-shirts with drug, alcohol, profane or offensive messages, short shorts/skirts, spaghetti strap shirts, halter tops, and midriff tops.
- <u>Shorts</u> may be worn only in the fall and spring: (August 29 – October 15 and April 15 – June 7)
- <u>Hats may not be worn indoors at any time, but may be worn outside.</u>
- <u>Jemicy shirt</u>: Each lower school student <u>must purchase one</u> navy-colored dress code shirt from Lands' End, with the Jemicy logo. The shirts will be used for field trips and other ventures off campus, as appropriate. This allows us to easily identify our students when we are out in a public area.
- <u>Shoes</u>: As the Lower School program is active and often incorporates the out-of-doors, students are encouraged to wear comfortable, closed-toe, athletic style shoes. *Flip flops are not permitted*.

Middle School

Students' dress in middle school should reflect pride in themselves and in the school. All clothing worn as part of the Jemicy School dress code must be clean, pressed, and in good condition (no rips or frayed edges). Undergarments (not including tighs) should not be visible at any time. The Dean of Students and Head of Middle School have final say regarding the appropriateness of a student's clothing.

Boys

Pants/Shorts

- School Uniform style pants of tan/khaki color.
- Same style of shorts, during the fall and spring. (August 29 – October 15 and April 15 – June 7)

Not acceptable: Any color other than tan/khaki, jeans/denim of any kind, corduroy, athletic shorts or sweat pants, and nylon/mesh material.

Shirts

Not acceptable: Any color other than tan/khaki, jeans/denim of any kind, corduroy, jeggings, leggings/tights not worn as undergarment, athletic shorts or sweat pants, and nylon/mesh material.

Shirts/Sweaters

• Lands' End mesh or interlock polo shirts, of any color, with embroidered school logo (short or long-sleeved) – order using school preferred # 9000-6683-8.

Sweaters, solid color sweatshirts, and pullover fleece.

• All are allowed to be worn over the polo shirt; left pocket printing only on sweatshirts and fleece (i.e. no large printing or graphics).
