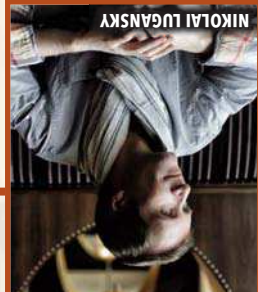
JORDI SAVALL & CONCERT DES NATIONS

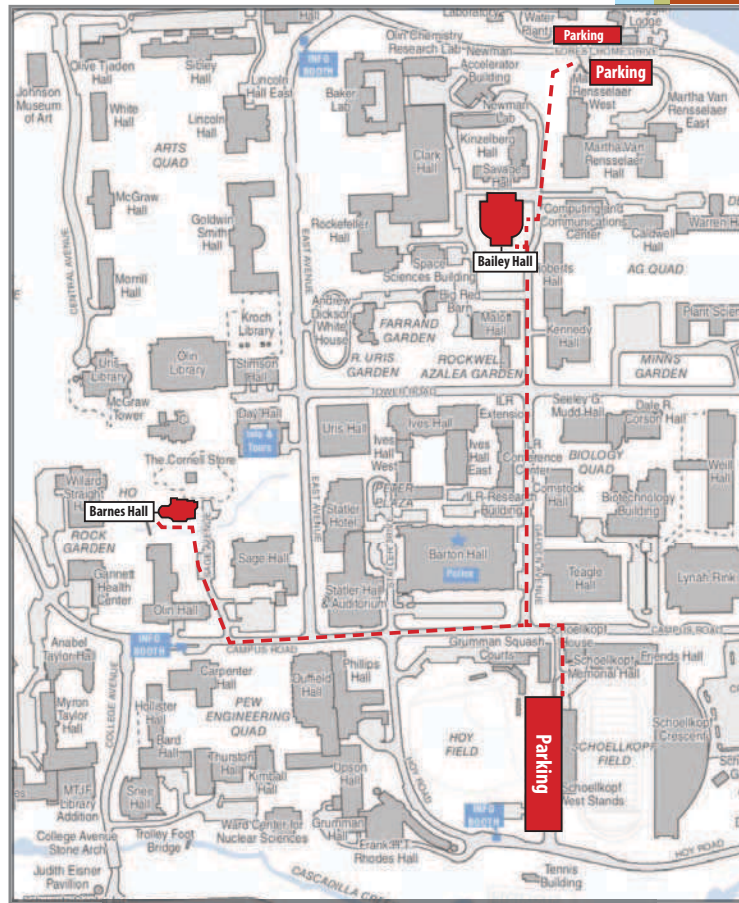
HANDICAP ACCESS & PARKING

An access ramp and elevator are located on the northeast and southwest sides of Bailey Hall. Please call 255.5144 or 254.3374 in advance to confirm wheelchair seating.

Vehicles displaying a valid handicap permit may use designated spaces available around the hall after hours. However, please note the additional restrictions posted for each specific parking area. Vehicles may not drive or park on the plaza pavement.

BOX OFFICE

Will-call and cash/check or credit card sales are available starting one hour prior to performance time. Bailey accepts Visa, Mastercard, and Discover. The Bailey box office serves as a show time box office only: for advance sales, please visit CornellConcertSeries.com or BaileyTickets.com.



Barnes Hall

The Schoellkopf Field garage is the largest parking option, but other nearby areas behind Willard Straight and Anabel Taylor Halls are also available on evenings and weekends. However please note the additional restrictions posted for each specific parking area.

Seating is unassigned and open in the auditorium, located on the upper floor of Barnes. An elevette is available, but please ask an usher for assistance in operating it. Call 255.5144 in advance to reserve a

wheelchair space. Advance tickets are sold online. Will-call and in-person sales start one hour prior to performance time at the Barnes Hall auditorium door.
