ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

To support the achievement of academic excellence, the Delphi Foundation of Delta Lambda Phi Fraternity has established an educational fund to award merit-based academic scholarships to members of Delta Lambda Phi National Social Fraternity on the basis of academics, leadership, and service.

The Delphi Foundation was formed for the purpose of serving as the "charitable arm" of Delta Lambda Phi Fraternity, to serve such educational, charitable, and philanthropic purposes that shall qualify under IRS rules as charitable activities, including educational scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be an active member of a chapter or colony of Delta Lambda Phi Fraternity, or an alumnus thereof (including neophytes of active colonies), in good-standing. Applicants must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in a post-secondary educational program at an accredited college or university (undergraduate or graduate level), accredited trade, or technical school. Brothers in any accredited post-graduate course of study are encouraged to apply, including, but not limited to, law school, medical school, graduate school, or seminary. Recipients of past year(s) scholarships remain eligible to apply.

The award is for recognition of academic excellence, leadership, service, or campus involvement. Applicants shall have a college grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better (on a scale of 4), cumulative or in the immediate past 4 semesters showing improvement if cumulative GPA is less than 2.5, or high school GPA of 2.5 or better for freshmen.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- (1) The application with each section filled as completely as possible. Typed/Printed applications are preferred, but due to the limitation to WORD and PDF file formats, legible hand-written applications are acceptable. When necessary due to space limitations, attach supplemental sheets for additional detail.
- (2) Transcripts from all coursework and schools attended. Copies and facsimiles of official transcripts are acceptable when obtaining sealed originals are a hardship. When applicable, include letters of acceptance or enrollment in your major, graduate program, or course of study.
- (3) An essay describing your contribution/service to one of the following: the Fraternity, your chapter or colony, your campus, a charitable program, or the GLBT community. How did this provide positive change for others? How did this change you, your attitudes, or your understanding? (Double-spaced, single-sided, 2-4 pages, 8 ½ x11)
- (4) Include at least two letters of reference:
 - A. From a Greek adviser, a $\Delta\Lambda\phi$ advisor, or chapter president, addressing your contributions to the Fraternity;
 - B. **From a community organization representative**, addressing your extra-curricular community involvement, contributions, and service;
 - C. From a campus-based organization representative, addressing your campus-based involvement, contributions, and service; and
 - D. **From a faculty member**, addressing your scholastic, major program, and academic achievements.

SELECTION PROCESS

A scholarship selection committee will review all applications with each member independently ranking each application. The ranking appraisal forms are collated and the scores are tallied to make final award determinations. Based on the number of applications, the committee reserves the right to make a single final selection, or select a group of scholarship finalists for a follow-up interview by members of the selection committee; with interviews to be conducted by phone. All applicants will be notified of the final status of their applications approximately six to eight (6-8) weeks after the application review process is completed.

Criteria for judging applications may include, but is not limited to: Applicant's contributions as a member, leader, role model, mentor, colleague, or advisor in $\Delta\Lambda\phi$; Service to campus; Service to community; or Academic standing. The scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, national origin, sexual orientation, or any other discriminating factor not disclosed herein.

ADMINISTRATION OF AWARD

Terms of the award: For the academic year (August to June) covered, the scholarship will be provided to the recipient to be applied toward tuition, fees, books, supplies, lab fees, or dissertation expenses. The Scholarship will be valid only for the year it is awarded. Since the scholarship fund is not currently based on endowment funding, the number and amount of awards may vary from year to year based on funding availability.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Applications and all supporting materials must be received by the Delphi Foundation NO LATER THAN **April 30**th. Timely and complete submission is the sole responsibility of each applicant. No grace period for submission will be granted. Incomplete applications will be rejected. Fax or e-mail submissions will not be accepted.
