Annual Membership Meeting

Elections

Each year the club membership elects Executive Board members at the annual membership meeting in January. The date and location of this year's meeting will be Monday January 11, 2016 at Panera Bread in Washington, near Sam's club in Trinity Point. The meeting will start promptly at 7:00 pm. Please patronize Panera, we are asked to spend at least \$50.00 to cover the cost of closing off the room for us. Please arrive earlier so as to be finished eating by 7:00! We have the room reserved from 5:30-8:30.

The Executive Board consists of a minimum of 8 and maximum of 12 members. The Executive Board members are elected to a two year term with some elected in alternate years. Nominations for Board Member seats will be accepted up to voting time at our meeting.

At the end of the year, most people reflect on the year and where they want to go in the New Year. This year is ending with **Jim Suffern** retiring from the board, and **Bob** and **Bernie Bodvake** stepping down. We do have 2 new Board members coming onto the Board – **Dave “Diz” Dean** is returning to the Board, and **Rich Vlainich** – but with the departure of **Jim**, **Bob**, and **Bernie**, we will only have 7 total active Board members. This is below the minimum of the 8 Board members our club bylaws call for.

Executive Board seats are filled by a membership secret ballot election with majority approval vote. Officers of the Board are President, Vice President of Events, Vice President of Activities, Secretary, Asst. Secretary and Treasurer. The remaining board members are Directors.

From the Executive Board, Officers are elected for a one year term. Officers of the Club are elected from the Executive Board members, by secret ballot at the February Board meeting each year, with majority vote.
