Acworth Business Association "Acworth All-American" Cheatham Scholarship

The Acworth Business Association "Acworth All-American" Gene Cheatham Scholarship is awarded to an outstanding high school senior who has participated in JROTC, succeeded academically, given back to their community and shown outstanding leadership qualities.

One (1) scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who currently attends a high school at North Cobb High School, Kennesaw Mountain High School, Allatoona High School or North Cobb Christian School.

The Acworth Business Association "Acworth All-American" Cheatham Scholarship will provide a \$500 award for financial support to offset the cost of educational expenses including, but not limited to, tuition, housing, board or books.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible for consideration by the Acworth Business Association Scholarship Selection Committee.

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior attending one of the following high schools: Allatoona, Kennesaw Mountain, North Cobb or North Cobb Christian.
- 2. Applicant must have demonstrated academic success with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 3. Applicant must have participated in JROTC at their high school.
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate active involvement/participation in extracurricular activities.
- 5. Applicant must demonstrate active participation within their community through community service.
- 6. Applicant must include a list of leadership positions held within their school, extracurricular activities and/or community.
- 7. Applicant must supply a copy of their high school transcript.
- 8. Applicant must intent to enroll full-time in an undergraduate program at a fully accredited two- or four-year college/university no later than Fall 2011. Applicants must supply a copy of the acceptance letter for her chosen college/university. NOTE: If acceptance letter is not available before application deadline, submit the application and indicate you are still waiting for the letter.
- 9. Applicant must submit a personal essay (500 words or less) outlining the applicant's future goals and aspirations and what it means to be "All-American".
- 10. Applicant must submit one (1) letter of support from individuals who are qualified to address the candidate's suitability for this award. Letter should be from a teacher, coach, principal, employer or pastor.
