Postcard Bourse Details

- 1. Table location will be determined by show management. Table fee of \$225 includes one 8 foot table with 8 foot backup table. Table fee of \$275 includes two 8 foot tables and one 6 foot table in a U-shape. No electrical hook-up is available.
- 2. You are a paid, pre-registered dealer upon payment in full of your bourse fee. The balance must be received no later than May 15, 2011. Mark your calendars for final payment deadline.
- 3. If you have a 2010 Currency dealer badge, bring it to the 2011 show. Postcard dealers will be issued a badge on Thursday. Dealers will be admitted to the bourse area at 12 noon on Thursday, June 9, 2011. No dealer or assistant will be permitted in the bourse area unless he/she is pre-registered and wears the official dealer badge. Early bird badges are available for \$75 for all non-table holders.
- **4.** On Friday, Saturday & Sunday, the show opens to dealers at 8:00 a.m. and to the public at 9:00 a.m. Show closes at 5:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday and 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- **5.** Security will end at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 12, 2011. Security room will be available on Wed. June 8th at 12 noon and close Thursday, June 9th at 12 noon. A fee of \$50 per person will be charged for storage.
- **6.** No refunds will be made on cancellations 30 days prior to show. For cancellation information, contact the show chairman.
- **7.** The bourse table assigned you may not be resold, rented, loaned, leased or shared by another dealer, individual or company without written consent of the bourse chairman.
- 8. Make checks payable to LFK Tradeshows.
- **9.** No paper money can be displayed or sold in the Postcard bourse area.
- **10.** Dealers are expected to have booths staffed, with inventory on display until the close of business on Sunday.
- 11. No dealer may knowingly exhibit or offer for sale any illegal coins, counterfeits, forgeries, unmarked copies or other spurious merchandise. The penalty for such action shall be immediate ejection of the dealer from the bourse and the possible suspension and/or subsequent expulsion from future Memphis conventions.
- **12.** Insurance against loss of material is the responsibility of the dealer.
- **13.** Show management reserves the right to revise show dates and/or hours.
- **14.** Dealers are responsible for compliance with all federal law, state law, local ordinances and state regulations including, but not limited to the Tennessee sales tax laws. We encourage all dealers to consult their legal and/or tax advisor as to their responsibility to do business at the Cook Convention Center.
