## Course Description and Objectives:

Chorus is a sequential class throughout grades 6-8 and is open to all students interested in learning about singing individually and in a group. Students will learn to sing using proper breath support, diction, body alignment, articulation, and tone. Additionally, they will sight-read and notate music to improve their music literacy skills. Through daily rehearsal, students will discover a variety of performance techniques and styles, texts and subject matters, and cultures.

## Participation:

Participation in chorus is a year-long commitment. School policy dictates that a student may not withdraw without written parental consent. Prior to withdrawal, parents are encouraged to speak with the director so that possible adjustments to their child's learning program may be attempted. No student will be dropped without prior parental notification. If withdrawal is necessary, it must be done at the conclusion of a semester. Goals and objectives for students with Individual Education Plans will be addressed in this course.
******Students must participate in a regularly-scheduled music class to be eligible for after-school ensembles. (This does not apply to the musical)

## Concert Participation Policy:

Chorus is a performance-based course and attendance at all concerts and performances is expected. Class time is spent on the development of individual and group voice technique, learning to understand musical notation, and acquiring the skills necessary to become "musical".

At the same time, middle school choral students are also developing in the areas of teamwork, citizenship, and their ever-increasing responsibilities. Through choral performance, students learn to "follow through" with commitments, overcome obstacles that might hinder participation, and to recognize the value of their membership within a group. The students learn to help take care of each other and reap the rewards that are derived from working within a group striving toward a common goal of excellence.

That being said, students' grades are impacted by their participation in dress rehearsals and performances. If a student has an emergency or illness that necessitates that he/she miss a required rehearsal or performance, he/she will be given the opportunity to complete an assignment of equal magnitude to take the place of his/her concert participation grade. Please communicate any
absences (other than severe illness or the loss of a family member) to Ms. Suslov with at least one week's notice.

Class Participation Policy:
All students are expected to participate fully. If a student is not feeling well enough to sing, he/she will be sent to the clinic. Students who are well enough to remain at school but are unable to sing will be expected to do an alternative assignment to earn his/her participation points for the day.

## Class Work:

A student who misses class work for any reason must make up the work when he/she returns to school. Failure to do so will result in a grade of $0 \%$. It is the student's responsibility to inquire about missed assignments.

## Recovery Process:

If your child needs to improve his/her grade in chorus, he/she may work with Ms. Suslov before or after school to raise his/her grade. Any additional assignments used to improve a grade will be determined by Ms. Suslov on a case-by-case basis.

## Extra Help:

Ms. Suslov is available on select days before and after school to work with students individually/in small groups. If class time does not allow, students may use this time to make up tests and quizzes.

## Consequences:

4 - 4th slip Detention 2 Use Webb Bridge detention slip and notification to parent OR Parent/Teacher/Student conference
5 - 5th slip Administrative Office Referral

Regardless of this change, any student who is not properly dressed in our uniform (whatever that change may be) will not be permitted to perform. The student will receive a grade of $50 \%$ for his/her concert participation grade.

## GMEA Statewide Sixth Grade Honor Chorus

Webb Bridge is able to send five students to Statewide Sixth Grade Honor Chorus. Statewide Sixth Grade Honor Chorus is in Athens, GA from February 19-20, 2015. Any student who is selected will need to attend the event with a parent/chaperone. The cost of registration and music is approximately $\$ 50$. In addition, each student will be responsible for the cost of his/her travel, hotel, and meals.

## GMEA All-State Chorus

$7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade choral students are eligible to audition for GMEA's All-State Chorus. Students who are selected for All-State Chorus must pass two rigorous auditions. The first audition will take place at Dutchtown High School in Hampton, GA on November 14, 2015. The second audition will take place on January 21, 2016 at North Springs High School in Sandy Springs, GA. All-State Chorus will take place from February 25th-27th in Athens, GA.
The audition process involves quite a bit of preparation, though the auditions and event itself are incredibly rewarding. Any student who is interested in auditioning should plan to practice with Ms. Suslov before and/or after school. Any student who is selected will need to attend the auditions and event with a parent/chaperone. The cost of registration and music is approximately $\mathbf{\$ 5 0}$. In addition, each student will be responsible for the cost of his/her travel, hotel, and meals.

## GMEA District V Honor Chorus

Webb Bridge may select $6^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ grade students to participate in GMEA District V Honor Chorus ( $6^{\text {th }}$ in the $4^{\text {th }}-6^{\text {th }}$ Grade Honor Chorus, $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ in the Middle School Honor Chorus). District Honor Chorus is a great way to meet other singers from Fulton County, Atlanta Public Schools, and the private schools in those districts. The event will take place on October 30-November 1 in the metro-Atlanta area. Please note that the performance on October $31^{\text {st }}$ will take place in the early afternoon. Please only commit this if your child is willing to postpone any Halloween celebrations until that evening! The cost of participation and music is approximately $\$ 45$.

## Georgia American Choral Directors Association Treble Honor Chorus

 GA ACDA Treble Honor Chorus is open by audition to any of our choral students with unchanged voices. The event will take place in June (exact date TBA) at Spivey Hall on the campus of Clayton State University. The cost of registration is approximately $\$ 65$. Each student must have a parent chaperone.
## Southern Division American Choral Directors Association Honor Chorus

 This year, the American Choral Directors Association's Southern Division's conference will take place in Chattanooga, TN. Since it is so close to Atlanta, we'd like to give our students the opportunity to audition for this prestigiousevent. To audition, students will need to submit a recorded track that they will create with Ms. Suslov's assistance before or after school. Auditions must be recorded in between September 11, 2015 and October 12, 2015. Students will be notified about the result of their audition on December 1, 2015.
Selected students will attend the event from March 9th-12th in Chattanooga. All participating students must attend with a parent chaperone.
