

Due to the popularity of the Survivor's shows, Central Montana is planning to do its own,


titled "Survivor -Montana Style."

Larry Nichols gave a ride report on the Sarpy Creek ride. They left Billings in good weather with 15 bikes and 23 people. They stopped at Sarpy Creek for lunch the food was good but a little slow. After leaving there they rode to Strokers in Huntley for a pop and then home. Dick Slagowksi gave the ride report for Powell. There were 15 bikes and 20 people. They left Billings and rode to Lovell for lunch at the Chinese buffet which was enjoyed by all and the price was right. After lunch they rode over to Horse Shoe Bend and then back to Billings. Good ride except for some rough roads and construction.

A motion was made by Dave Alder to approve last months minutes as written and was seconded by Jean Bushman. The motion passed.

Don gave treasurers report. The balance in the checking account is \$1421.83. After having paid for the news letter and bills for May. Don also reported that all the advertisers have paid for their ad except for one and that one should be coming and that all memberships are paid up. The income from the 50/50 drawing and the shake a day is up since the changes in the rules.

Darrell gave a report for Cheryl on the news letter. 
Darrel announced that the club made new nametags for the e-board members and that members could also by a nametag for \$4.50. If anyone would like to by one to let him know and he will get them one.





WIND CHILL

Cold wind blasts can rapidly cool your body temperature and reduce your riding time in between stops. If the outside temperature is 30 degrees Fahrenheit and you're riding at a speed of 50 mph, the wind chill temperature that your body will feel is 12 degrees Fahrenheit.

The National Weather Service implemented a replacement Wind Chill Temperature (WCT) index last year. The new formula uses advances in science, technology, and computer modeling to give everyone a more accurate and useful formula for calculating the dangers from winds. As you see in our new chart (which for now has the old WCT and new WCT calculated) the new calculations are a bit more realistic and eventually will be taken a bit more serious by folks.

Standardization of the WCT Index among the meteorological world provides an accurate and consistent measure. This in turn will keep everyone safer in extreme conditions. But it doesn't have to get very extreme on a motorcycle to feel very cold. Wind Chill Blasts can rapidly cool your body temperature and reduce your riding time in between stops. If the outside temperature is 50 degrees at 60 mph the wind chill temperature that your body will feel is 39 degrees Fahrenheit.

Even at these temperatures Frostbite times are as low as 30 minutes. Windshields block the wind and in turn greatly help to increase the WCT so you stay warmer.

Back to the Basics— June Wingworld

Maybe you're just getting into motorcycle touring. Or maybe you're just getting back to it after many years absence. Maybe you've been a short distance, around-town rider and now want to ride cross-state or cross-country. Here are some tips on motorcycle touring no matter what you are riding.

"You Go Where You Look"

- When walking or running, your body automatically tends to go where you look.
- On a motorcycle, your head and eye positions prompt physical inputs to the bike's steering.
- Look through a corner to where you want to exit and you'll corner easier.
- Want to turn a sharper U-turn? Turn your head and look over your shoulder.
- Want to stop diving left or right at stop signs? Keep your eyes and head on the horizon as you brake to a complete stop!

This really works. They taught us this in the motorcycle safely course. CB Thanks for the information, Darrel!




