History Of The Middle Finger



Well, now.....here's something I never knew before, and now that I know it, I feel compelled to send it on to my more intelligent friends in the hope that they, too, will feel edified. Isn't history more fun when you know something about it?

Before the Battle of Agincourt in 1415, the French, anticipating victory over the English, proposed to cut off the middle finger of all captured English soldiers. Without the middle finger it would be impossible to draw the renowned English longbow and therefore they would be incapable of fighting in the future. This famous English longbow was made of the native English Yew tree, and the act of drawing the longbow was known as "plucking the yew" (or "pluck yew").

Much to the bewilderment of the French, the English won a major upset and began mocking the French by waving their middle fingers at the defeated French, saying, See, we can still pluck yew!

Since 'pluck yew' is rather difficult to say, the difficult consonant cluster at the beginning has gradually changed to a labiodentals fricative F', and thus the words often used in conjunction with the one-finger-salute!

It is also because of the pheasant feathers on the arrows used with the longbow that the symbolic gesture is known as "giving the bird."





Heath Salad

- 3-4 cups fresh spinach (yummy)
- 1 carrot shredded
- 2 ounces chopped and cooked Canadian Bacon
- 1/2 cup raisins
- 3 hard-cooked eggs- chopped
- 1 cup fresh bean sprouts
- 1/4 cup sunflower seeds
- 1/2 Surprise dressing (see below)

Makes 4 Portions

Spinach: wash, dry and tear into bite-size pieces. In large bowl, combine spinach, carrot, bacon, raisins, egg, bean sprouts and sunflower seeds. Just before serving, toss with dressing.

Surprise Dressing

- 1/2 cup evaporated skim milk
- 1- 6 ounce can frozen orange juice concentrate, thawed
- Pinch of ground ginger

Mix milk, orange juice and ginger. Shake well before using.

Emergency Treatment for Heatstroke

Call 911 if you or anyone you know is experiencing any of the following during a heat wave:

- Loss of consciousness
- Moderate to severe difficulty breathing
- Rapid heartbeat
- Severe vomiting and diarrhea
- Seizures

Confusion, severe restlessness or anxiety
Hot, dry, flushed skin, with no sweating or with excessive sweating.

Move the person into a cooler place, out of direct sunlight. Remove unnecessary clothing and place the person on his or her side to expose as much skin surface to the air as possible.

Cool the person's body by sponging or spraying cool (not cold) water on him and fanning him. Apply ice packs to the groin, neck and armpits, where large blood vessels lie close to the skin surface. So not immerse the person in an ice bath.

Check the person's rectal temperature frequently and try to cool it to 102.3 degrees.

Do not give aspirin or acetaminophen to reduce high body temperature with heat stroke. These medications may cause problems in the case of heatstroke.

If the person is awake and alert enough to swallow, help him drink fluids.
