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The Direct Debit Guarantee

- This is a guarantee provided by your own Bank/Building Society as a member of the Direct Debit Scheme, in which Banks/Building Societies and Originators of Direct Debits participate.
- If you authorise payment by Direct Debit, then your Direct Debit Originator will notify you in advance of the amounts to be debited to your account.
- Your Bank/Building Society will accept and pay such debits, provided that your account has sufficient available funds.
- If it is established that an unauthorised Direct Debit was charged to your account, you are guaranteed a prompt refund by your Bank/Building Society of the amount so charged.
- You can cancel the Direct Debit Instruction in good time by writing to your Bank.
