The course includes reading and interpreting prescriptions and defining drugs by generic and brand names. Students will learn dosage calculations, I.V. flow rates, drug compounding, dose conversions, dispensing of prescriptions, inventory control and billing and reimbursement. The Pharmacy Technician Certification Program includes a graded final exam to help prepare students for the national PTCB exam.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

To protect your health and the health of patients, the State of Texas has implemented a system of required immunizations for all healthcare students in direct patient contact. The following immunizations must be complete prior to registering in the **clinical** phase of any healthcare program

Varicella (chicken pox) -

two doses, report of a positive titer*, or reported date of illness

Tetanus/Diptheria (Td) one dose within the past 10 years

Hepatitis B -

series must be completed before start date of class (first shot is taken, second shot is due one month later, third shot is due 6 months after first shot)

Tuberculin Skin Test (TB) -

negative reading within 6 months of class start date is required (if you have a positive reading, a negative chest x-ray is required)

(test results or x-ray signed by doctor required)

MMR - (combined Measles, Mumps, & Rubella)

born in or after 1957 - two doses at least one month apart or positive titer* required

born before 1957 - one dose or positive titer* required --or--

Measles -

born in or after 1957 - two doses at least one month apart or positive titer* required

Mumps -

born in or after 1957 - one dose or positive titer* required

Rubella -

One dose or positive titer* required

*Titer results signed by doctor are required.

Students will be immediately withdrawn with no refund issued if found to have falsified information or if immunizations are not complete.

The State of Texas requires that all students working in direct patient contact during the clinical phase of a course, meet certain requirements. The requirements are outlined on our Healthcare Admissions Application. You must complete this application and submit it at least 10 days prior to the start of class. ALL immunizations must be complete and proof of CPR certification attached prior to submitting the application. Once submitted, we will complete the criminal background check and if all requirements are met, you will be notified of eligibility to register.

Medical Assistant Lecture/Lab

This course is designed to provide the student with the necessary training, skills, and knowledge needed to gain employment as a Medical Assistant in a physician office or clinic setting. The student will have instruction in a variety of laboratory procedures such as phlebotomy and EKGs as well as infection control, ethics, medical office technology and so much more. This class is one of the two required courses needed in order to be awarded a certificate of completion for this program. The clinical portion will be offered in Spring 2009. The clinical portion will require all immunizations, CPR certification and a criminal background check.

It includes vacuum collection devices, syringes, capillary skin puncture, butterfly needles, blood culture and specimen collection. This class is one of the two required courses needed in order to be awarded a certificate of completion for this program. The clinical portion will be offered in Spring 2009. The clinical portion will require all immunizations, CPR certification and a criminal background check.

Students will learn to operate a 12-lead EKG machine, identify heart rhythms, and recognize normal and abnormal patterns in the EKG leads. This class is one of the two required courses needed in order to be awarded a certificate of completion for this program. EKG Technician Clinical will be offered in Spring 2009. The clinical portion will require all immunizations, CPR certification and a criminal background check.

Students must bring their Medication Aide permit number to class so the hours can be properly reported to DADS. Students must register 2 weeks before start date of class.

This is a skills training course with topics and applicable skills relevant to cardiac emergencies.

EMT Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS)

A special intensive skills training course in emergency field management for the EMT-Intermediate, EMT-Paramedic, and Trauma Nurse who must initially evaluate the trauma patient. The course includes training in basic and advanced skills necessary for rapid assessment, resuscitation, immobilization and the transport of patients. This course was designed by the American College of Emergency Physicians.

EMT Basic

The course content includes lecture and skills which concentrate on the Department of Health EMT basic guidelines in all aspects of pre-hospital emergency care. The course clinical and EMS requirement remain the same but the lecture portion of the course will change to follow the National Assessment Based curriculum. The course includes basic emergency care designed for those actively treating sick or injured persons. Students will also be required to perform 24 hours of hospital internship in the ER and ride as an EMS crew member for 24 hour emergency ambulance runs. Successful completion of the course makes the student eligible for the Texas Department of Health EMT-Basic Certification Fxam.
