Affidavit for North Carolina Residency for Tuition Purposes

___ 1. I am an independent person and have maintained legal residence in North Carolina for at least 12 months. (Documentation is required. Examples: tax returns, electric bill, rental agreement, driver’s license.)

___ 2. I am a dependent person and my parent or court appointed legal guardian has maintained legal residence in North Carolina for at least 12 months. (Documentation for each participant is required – see # 1)

___ 3. I am a dependent person who has resided for five years with an adult relative other than my parents or legal guardian and my relative has maintained legal residence in North Carolina for at least 12 months. (Documentation for each participant is required – see # 1)

___ 4. I am married to a person who has maintained legal residence in North Carolina for at least 12 months. I have established legal residence and intend to make North Carolina my permanent home. (A copy of the marriage certificate and proof of 12 months of domicile of the spouse is required)

___ 5. I am a member of the United States armed services stationed in North Carolina on active military duty or whose home of record is North Carolina, or I am the member’s spouse or dependent child. (Copy of military orders showing home of record is North Carolina may be required. 12 month domicile not required)

___ 6. A North Carolina public college/university declared me a resident for tuition purposes.

(Verification from the institution is required)

___ 7. I was previously enrolled at a North Carolina state college/university and classified as a North Carolina resident for tuition purposes. I abandoned my North Carolina domicile less than 12 months ago, and I am now re-establishing North Carolina legal residence. (Verification of enrollment from prior institution is required)

___ 8. I am an employee of a North Carolina based employer who is paying for my tuition. (The following documents will be required: (a) A letter from employer verifying they will pay for the student’s particular semester, (b) A pay stub from the employer proving employment. 12 Month domicile not required)

___ 9. I am an employee who has been transferred by my employer to a position in North Carolina.
(Official documentation of transfer from employer is required. 12 month domicile not required)

___ 10. My tuition is being paid for by a North Carolina based non-profit agency.
(The following documents will be required: (a) Articles of Incorporation or proof of the entity's non-profit status (b) A letter from the non-profit stating their intent to pay for the student's particular semester. 12 month domicile not required)

___ 11. According to the United States Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS), I am a permanent resident alien or other legal alien granted indefinite stay and have maintained a domicile in North Carolina for at least 12 months. (USCIS documentation is required. The return of a filing receipt from USCIS is required and constitutes the beginning of the 12 month period)

___ 12. I am an individual who has lawfully entered the United States as a refuge (political asylum). USCIS documentation will be required but it is sometimes difficult to obtain – see Director of International Students. (12 month domicile not required)
