Blount, C. Richard

The Reverend Richard "Dick" Blount passed away October 22, 2013. He was born June 25, 1928 in Fulton, MO. Dick and Sue were married August 27, 1948. She preceded him in death. He did undergraduate studies at the University of Missouri, Columbia and Westminster College, received degrees from Central Methodist (College) University and Emory University, and did post-graduate studies at the University of Missouri, Kansas City.
