2015 ANNUAL MASSPARKS PASS

- Mansfield Parks & Recreation has one Department of Conservation and Recreation MassParks pass for the 2015 season that may be reserved and borrowed by Mansfield residents by calling 508.851.6458 or emailing recreation@mansfieldma.com.
- The MASSParks Pass entitles the bearer to free parking for one vehicle (excluding buses or vans) at over 50 facilities in the Massachusetts state parks system that charge a day-use parking fee.
- Borrowers may pick up the pass the day of the booked date, and may return the pass by noon the following day. A deposit fee of \$10.00 is required to borrow the pass; the \$10.00 will be returned to the borrower when the pass is returned to the Recreation Office.
- Passes may only be borrowed by Mansfield residents over 18 with valid identification.
- If you cannot use the pass for the day it is reserved, you must call and cancel. Failure to cancel with 24 hours notice may result in loss of privileges for three months.
- A FINE OF \$5.00 PER DAY IS CHARGED FOR LATE PASSES. Patrons who are repeatedly late will no longer be allowed to borrow the pass. If the pass is lost, the fee to replace it must be paid by the patron.
- PLEASE REMEMBER: You are sharing this pass with others. Please be considerate and return the pass on time.
