Completed applications must be postmarked no later than <u>March 23, 2009</u>. Applications postmarked after this deadline will not be considered.

AWARD COMPONENTS:

CRITERIA:

 Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited two or four year Western New England College or University (Graduate or Undergraduate) at the time of award. Graduate students must have entered graduate school immediately after receiving their undergraduate degree. Selected recipients are strongly encouraged to attend 2nd Annual NABA Night of Stars" – A Scholarship and Awards Celebration.
Applicant must demonstrate one of the following – Need, Academic Excellence or Civic Responsibility in your Community.

3. The application MUST be completed in its entirety, submitted with the items listed below. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

PLEASE INCLUDE:

- 1. Completed application with essay (typed doubled space, 500 words please).
- 2. Personal statement describing your personal and academic goals, including volunteer and other extracurricular activities.
- 3. Official copy of most recent transcript.
- 4. Full contact information (ie. address home and school, phone number, email address, etc.)

Note: NABA GHC is not responsible for items lost or improperly handled by the mail carrier services. We recommend having the scholarship package sent by certified mail. Please plan carefully so that your application receives the consideration it deserves.

SCHOLARSHIP RETRIEVAL:

The actual cash awards will be made after receipt of proof of enrollment for the period(s) covered by the award.

Deadline for application is <u>March 23, 2009</u>. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
