- The Bee Nilson Scholarship is awarded based on academic achievement. The number of awards may vary from year to year.
- The advice, recommendation and ranking of the Heads of Departments of Human Nutrition and Food Science. The Scholarships Office contacts the relevant Heads of Departments in early November for assessment.

Academic record

- We will obtain a current transcript.

What happens next...

- Your application will be acknowledged by email. Please be aware that this may take up to a week after the application has been received by the Scholarships Office.
- Letters notifying the outcome of applications for this award will be posted to all candidates before 24 December.

- The offer of a Scholarship or Award does not guarantee a place in the Department. You should apply separately for admission to your course.
