## ECUA Lift Station Milestone Sign-Off Sheet



- ECUA requires notification, inspection, and approval of milestone construction activities prior to subsequent
  construction activities to help insure problems, if any, are caught and corrected at the proper time. Sheet shall
  be given to Contractor at pre-construction meeting, and Contractor shall keep sheet on project site for ECUA
  Inspector's use throughout project.
- 2. Contractor shall notify the ECUA Inspector at least 2 full business days prior to commencement of each activity (or group of activities if practical) listed below to allow for coordination, inspection, and approval. Failure to provide required notification and obtain ECUA sign-offs may result in rejection or reconstruction of subsequent work at Contractor's expense.
- 3. The ECUA Inspector and/or Lift Station and/or Instrument/Electrical staff shall initial each activity upon successful completion, thus clearing project for the next activity.
- 4. Contractor shall submit copy of completed sheet for each Lift Station to ECUA Inspector as part of Final Inspection process. Failure to submit completed sheet will result in delaying Final Completion status.
