Facilities are judged on their design layout, clean operation, maintenance performance practices, and community activities. Winners and Finalists of NAPA's Ecological Awards will be recognized at the 2013 NAPA Midyear Meeting.

## ELIGIBILITY

The NAPA Ecological Awards are open to all NAPA Producer members. The plant must have received a current year Diamond Achievement Commendation (first time or renewal).

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete this form, include payment for entry fee of \$125.00.
2. Include a brief description of the facility (see page 2). Include any unique features, zoning challenges, and community activities. Please include examples of community outreach programs, i.e., newspaper articles, letters from officials, etc.
3. Attach five 8" x 10" original, glossy, color photographs. NOTE: Must include photos of the main entrance to the facility as seen from an access road, the plant in action, the plant in its surroundings, stockpile area, and overview of the plant. Photos need to be of professional quality, suitable for reproduction. If taken with a digital camera, you must submit both a CD and prints. Resolution must be at least 300 dpi.
4. All completed forms must be **postmarked no later than December 1, 2012.**
