Application for Honors Research Fund

Purpose: Honors students may apply individually or in groups for funding to support activities that enhance their undergraduate education. Only Honors students (or groups comprised entirely of Honors students) are eligible to apply.

Examples of learning opportunities that would be eligible for Honors Research Funding:

- Research, scholarship, and artistic activities or materials
- International service opportunities
- Participation in academic conferences
- Study abroad, particularly that with a research focus
- Matching funds for URCO or other academic grants

Examples of requests that are NOT eligible for Honors Research Funding:

- Equipment purchases (such as iPods, digital cameras, etc.)
- Domestic service trips
- Trips of a personal nature
- Tuition for courses

Criteria: Students must be enrolled at Utah State University with good standing in the University Honors Program .

First time applicants will receive priority.

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis throughout the academic year. The application form (below) must be completed fully. Applications will be evaluated only once students have submitted a completed application form, a one-page budget description, and a letter of support from a faculty member.

Students selected to receive an Honors Research Award must submit a 1-2 page final report to the Honors Program within one month of using their funding. The report should describe and explain the benefits of the experience for which the student received the award.

Award amounts vary, but may range from \$50 to \$500. Students may request a Research Award even if the total amount of the event or experience exceeds \$500.

Information that may help you secure matching funding:

The ASUSU Academic Opportunity Fund supports student participation in professional conferences. A form is available on the Undergraduate Research website. The Undergraduate Research & Creative Opportunities (URCO) Grant features two competitions during the academic year: October 15 and February 15. Information is available at <http://research.usu.edu/undergrad>. See Funding Opportunities. Some departments may also match funding from the University Honors Program.

NOTE: Students who complete a minimum of two semesters of research, disseminate the results, and have the approval of a faculty mentor may apply for an *Undergraduate Research Scholar* transcript designation. The application is also on the Undergraduate Research website.
