The New Testament contains 21 epistles of which 13 are attributed to the writings of St. Paul. Modern scholars agree that St. Paul wrote at least seven of the 13 letters. Insight into each category of the letters at well at an explanation of Paul's fundamental teaching of salvation history, Jesus, the Church, and Christian living will be discussed.
