

Code of Conduct FOR Y DANCERS

A signed Code of Conduct Agreement will be required from all students in Adv Beginner, Intermediate and Jr level classes. Non-compliance will result in a call to parents.

1. A Health/Release Form must be on file for all students before the first lesson, updated yearly.
2. Parent should sign student in and out of weekly classes. Students over 6 years old may sign themselves in and out with their release form signed by a parent.
3. Be present and prepared for class no less than 5 minutes before class begins. Call if late or absent.
4. Dress Requirements (Further details are in the Brochure)
 - solid color leotard- no bare midriffs
 - pink tights for ballet or combination classes
 - tan tights for tap, jazz and modern (footless for modern) classes
 - shoes: pink leather ballet shoes, black low top jazz sneakers
 - teachers will give further instructions on jazz pants, tap shoes, lyrical shoes and warm-up wear
 - NO DANCE SHORTS
5. Ballet buns for all ballet classes. Short hair should be neatly secured away from the face. No long bangs. Other dance forms will give further instructions on hair.
6. No Jewelry, other than small pierced earrings.
7. Attendance is important and will be taken each week. Students in Beginner II levels and above may miss no more than 7 classes for the year to participate in the June performance.

All teachers will be upholding these guidelines and may make additional requests.
