

WILLIAM AARON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- 1. Applicant must be a full time student enrolled in the Mortuary Science Program at Mesa Community College, Williams Education Center.
- 2. Applicant must be a resident of the state of Arizona.
- 3. To be eligible for an Arizona Funeral, Cemetery & Cremation Association Scholarship the following items must be submitted:
 - a. A cover letter explaining why applicant believes he/she is a worthy candidate for the scholarship (financial need will be taken into consideration but is not the determining factor.)
 - b. An essay, not less than 1000 words or more than 2500 words, entitled "Why I Want To Be a Funeral Director". Essays must be typewritten, double spaced, with one-inch margins. Essays containing spelling, punctuation or grammatical errors will be subject to automatic disqualification. The essay may be published, and applicant, by his/her submission, waives any copyright or other intellectual property right over it.
 - c. Verification from Mesa Community College that applicant is a full time student enrolled in the Mortuary Science Program and is maintaining a "B" or better grade average, along with a letter of recommendation from a faculty member.
- 4. Scholarships will be awarded at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors of the
- Arizona Funeral, Cemetery & Cremation Association based on the evaluation of the above named items. All scholarship awards will be paid directly to Mesa Community College for the benefit of the applicant.
- 6. All Applications must be postmarked by December 14th in the first year of enrollment.
- 7. The scholarship is for \$1,000.
