INSTRUCTIONS North Carolina State Bar Application for Certification as a Specialist

- 1. <u>Standards</u> Read the North Carolina Plan of Specialization and the standards for certification in your specialty area. These materials are found at 27 N.C.A.C. 1D, Sect. 1700 *et seq.* and are published in the North Carolina State Bar *Lawyer's Handbook* and on our website www.ncbar.gov.
- 2. <u>Fees</u> A filing fee of \$250 must accompany this application. All checks should be payable to North Carolina State Bar Board of Legal Specialization. Rejection or withdrawal of an application will not entitle an applicant to a refund of the fee or any part of the fee. Applications received by June 16, 2014, will qualify for a \$50 discount on the application fee. An exam fee of \$150 will be due and payable upon notification that an applicant is eligible to take a specialty examination. *Additional exam fees apply for joint certification with national certifying agencies in bankruptcy and elder law.
- 3. <u>Filing Timeliness</u> The completed application shall be considered timely filed if the application is delivered to the offices of the North Carolina State Bar before 5:00 p.m. on July 1, 2014, or is postmarked no later than July 1, 2014.

4. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FORM

- A. **PLEASE ANSWER EACH QUESTION.** If additional space is needed to answer a question, please attach pages to the application.
- B. **WAIVER of STRICT COMPLIANCE** If an applicant cannot meet the strict requirements for substantial involvement or CLE for a specialty, the applicant may request a waiver of strict compliance. To do so, you must complete the waiver of strict compliance form, available on the website http://www.nclawspecialists.gov/forms.asp and submit the form with your application.
- C. **REFERENCES** Each applicant for certification is asked to submit the names and addresses of 10 references in support of his or her application. It is preferred that references have experience in the applicable specialty. The extent of a reference's involvement in the applicable specialty and relationship to the applicant will be considered in the evaluation process. All references will be contacted by the Board Legal Specialization, or its representatives, and asked to complete written peer reference statements. A minimum of 5 complete peer reference statements must be received in order for an application to advacne. The applicant is not responsible for asking the listed references to complete the forms. The Board, or its representatives, may contact, in person or by telephone, any reference listed by an applicant or any other lawyer or judge qualified to evaluate the applicant's competence and qualification in the specialty area.
- D. **SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION FORMS** Please note the specialties marked with an asterisk * on the following page and submit the supplemental application form, available on the website http://www.nclawspecialists.gov/forms.asp with your application in those specialty areas.
- 5. <u>Processing of Applications</u> Only completed applications will be reviewed by the Board of Legal Specialization. Each applicant will be notified by mail of acceptance or rejection of his or her application.

- 6. <u>Examination</u> Upon the board's determination that applicant is qualified to sit for a specialty exam, a confirmation notice with the time and location of the examination will be sent to you. The exam schedule is online at: <u>www.nclawspecialists.gov/becoming</u>. Examination results are provided by mail.
- 7. **Confidentiality** All information contained in the application, supporting documents, peer reference information and statements, and examination results shall be confidential and unless otherwise subject to the North Carolina Public Records Act but shall be available for use only by the Board, the appropriate specialty committee, or any appropriate body or tribunal in the event of an appeal.
- 8. <u>Special Testing Accommodations for Disabled Applicants</u> A written request for special accommodations, supported by documentation of disability, must be submitted to the executive director at least two weeks prior to the exam.

Members of the Board of Legal Specialization and members of the applicable specialty committee may not serve as references. A complete list of committee members is included at the end of the application. You may advise your peer references that you have listed them on this application.
