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"Netiquette: Courtesy in the Online World"

To be a good cybercitizen, kids need to know the proper etiquette, or rules for social behavior, when using the Internet. This "netiquette" is an important component of cyber ethics, codes of conduct that should

guide actions online. Whether our kids are using a computer at school or home, sending an email or tweet, taking part in a chat room discussion, or playing a game, they should have proper netiquette at the forefront of their minds. Cyberbullying, which is defined by the National Crime Prevention Council as using smartphones, laptops, or other electronic devices to "send or post information or images meant to hurt or embarrass others," is not just improper netiquette, but also potentially destructive and even dangerous. Netiquette requires children to not only keep emotions in check, but to also think carefully before hitting send.
