Nominees for the award will be judged on the following criteria:

- ✧ Consistency in their level of work over the twelve months. Employees with less than eighteen months service with their current employer will not be considered.
- ✧ Out performing their peers, primarily in terms of quality of work but balanced by the level of output – this may include factors like fast turnaround times, low repeat work rates, high levels of customer praise.
- ✧ Ongoing commitment to learning, which may include internal and or external training, showing initiative in research, and/or actively participating in knowledge transfer.

Nominees can be in any work category, and at any level, provided in your (organisation's) opinion they display qualities worthy of such an award.

Successful nominees will receive their awards at a Presentation Dinner to be held by the Rotary Club of Salisbury on 23rd February 2009.

Representatives of your organisation would be welcome to attend.
