John Rennie founded the Triangle Futbol Club in 1999, then known as Triangle Soccer Academy, as Head Coach of Duke Men's soccer, alongside Anson Dorrance (UNC Women), Elmar Bolowich (UNC Men), Billy Hempen (Duke Women), George Tarrantini (NCSU Men) and Laura Kerrigan (NCSU Women). Rennie served as president of TFC for almost 8 years steering the club to new heights in player development and expanding the full time staff with professional coaches to serve the greater Triangle area for aspiring youth soccer players.

Rennie was the Duke Men's coach for 29 years, reaching the College Cup 5 times and National Champions in 1986. Duke also won 5 ACC titles during Rennie's tenure. He's been a USSF national coaching staff member and served as the head coach of the South Region Olympic Development Program. In 2011, John Rennie was inducted into the North Carolina Soccer Hall of Fame.

- Current or Most Recent High School Transcript (in sealed envelope)
- 2 Letters of Recommendation (in sealed envelopes)
 - One letter from a teacher or administrator at candidate's current high school
 - One letter of personal reference from a pastor, guidance counselor, coach, employer or other qualified individual
