- MUST COMPLETE AND RETURN CURRENT TERM APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF FINANCIAL AID

- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The Alabama Student Assistance Program is a needs-based program. All applicants will be considered on a needs basis.
- Legal residency will be verified with the Office of Admissions adhering to the admissions policy.
- The award amount will be at the discretion of the awards officer based on criteria as mandated by the Alabama Commission on Higher Education.
- The awards officer will narrow the selection of applicants based on additional eligibility requirements as needed based on grant funding received for disbursement. Examples of additional eligibility requirements can include ranking by G.P.A and exclusion if additional sources of funding are currently being received.
