- Both Undergraduate & Postgraduate students are eligible for participation in the Hardware Competition.
- The competing projects must be of Final Year Student Level.

Hardware Competition

Sample Abstract Format

Project Title:

The name of your project appears here.

Field of Science:

The field of engineering your project focuses on. (e.g., Electronics, Telecommunication, Mechanical etc. ...).

Hardware Requirements

Scribble the details of the apparatus you required (or expect us to provide you with, at the exhibition) for the functioning of your project.

Practical Applications:

Jot down the practical implementations your project proposes or any application it could be used for. How does it supercede the already implied methods or how can one benefit by using your proposed solutions.

Background and Justification:

Write down the research work carried out in the field of your work, and propose your solution with the advancements, enhancements or innovations you've contributed to the task.

NOTE:

- The abstract should not exceed THREE (3) papers of an electronic document.
- Fonts should be made clear and readable, preferably of the type "Times New Roman", Size: 12.
