## C STREET LANDING

## A prime peoplewatching and river access spot overlooking the Turning Basin, the C Street Landing will feature a

 downtown launching and landing ramp for small craft, a reconstruction of the fishing pier built in $\qquad$ by the Kiwanis Club, and connectors to the Warehouse District Boardwalk (14), amphitheater seating at the C Street Pump Station (11), and docks in front of the Yacht Club and Trestle.Although this project has a small footprint on land, it will serve as an intersection for downtown foot and trolley traffic and water-based activities, from boating to fishing to gazing upon the many colorful craft that ply Petaluma's waterfront daily. As such, it will be a hub of activity symbolizing Petaluma's vibrant waterfront economy and society.
