1. The Langley Club Advisory Committee Meeting was held in the Daedalian Room, 128 Benedict Ave, on 11 Aug 2014 at 1130.

- 3. COL Ladner, the new 633 ABW/CV expressed a desire to send a letter out to all squadron and group commanders on the importance of the club advisory committee and to invite them to appoint a club member assigned to their unit as committee representative. Mrs. Pabon and Mrs. Adams informed COL Ladner the club is approximately 75% retirees and 25% active duty and the club has the 5th highest membership in the entire Air Force club system and is one of the few that is profitable.
- 4. Mrs. Pabon briefed the financial results for the 3rd quarter of FY14: Total sales were \$317.1K, support/services fees were \$70K, concession income was \$1.8K, dues income was \$97.6K, total sales and activity revenue were \$371K, personnel expense was \$237K, material related expenses were \$24.5K, entertainment and promotional expenses were \$14.9K, utilities were 42.7K and the Net Income Adjusted for Depreciation (NIAD) was a positive \$36.2K. Until acclimated, COL Ladner requested a copy of the club's financial briefing be provided to him prior to the next several advisory meetings. (CLOSED)

5. Old Business:

- a. The club hosted a pool party with HUNT on 23 Jul 2014; it was a huge success and well received by all who attended. HUNT and club management have discussed working together on a wine tasting event but the details and dates have not yet been decided. The club will continue to work with HUNT with developing future programs. (CLOSED)
- b. Starting in October 2014, the club will offer Sunday Brunch each Sunday from 1000-1330 in the Langley Club's Ballroom. Menu and pricing are still being finalized and management will

contact the chapel so that the information can be added to the church bulletins. October will be a trial period to see if the membership will support this new program. Management will review sales and participation in early November to determine the long-term prospects of brunch. (OPEN)

6. New Business:

The millwork for the bar and back bar are being manufactured and the new bar equipment, bar walk-in and draft beer system have been ordered. (OPEN)
